An Introduction to Health Technology Assessment

Presenter: Laura Sawyer

This introductory course is designed to teach participants about the key elements, methods and language of health technology assessment (HTA). The course provides an overview of basic HTA principles and processes, including the assessment of benefits (systematic reviews, comparative efficacy and safety, evidence synthesis, real-world evidence), evaluation of cost-effectiveness (costing, pharmacoeconomic modelling, budget impact analysis) and the larger social and health systems context in which HTA operates. The course will review the practical steps involved in developing and using HTA reports and group discussion will focus on the perspectives of different stakeholders and the implementation of HTA in health care decision making.
